ORDER:

In the Government orders first read above, orders were issued for constitution of State/District Level Societies of Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Society (TNRTS). The Memorandum of Association and Bye-Laws of the Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Society and District Rural Transformation Societies were approved and the State Level Society was registered.

2. In the Government order second read above, the Government has approved the operational manuals for the projects which includes Procurement manual, Human Resource Manual and Finance Manual along with the Project Implementation Plan for Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project.

3. In the reference third read above, The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project has stated that Government of India has sanctioned the Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project, World Bank assisted project with aim and objective of building sustainability and prosperity of rural communities through enterprise promotion, access to finance and employment opportunities. The Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project agreement was signed between the World Bank and the Government of Tamil Nadu at the office of Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Government of India, New Delhi on 30.01.2018. The Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Government of India requested to obtain the Legal Opinion from the Advocate General of Tamil Nadu on the Project Agreement in order to give effect to the project.

4. The Legal opinion in the prescribed proforma from the Advocate General of Tamil Nadu on the Project agreement of the Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project signed between the IBRD (World Bank) and the Government of Tamil Nadu was forwarded to the Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Government of India, New Delhi requesting to declare the Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project as effective. The project was declared as "Effective by the World Bank on 28.2.2018. As per the Project Implementation Plan, the duration of the project will be six years from the date of approval of the project. The Project will be implemented with loan assistance from International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (World Bank) with a total Project cost of Rs.918.20 Crores (142.85 million US\$) spread over 6 years. 70% will be the loan assistance from the World Bank and 30% will be contribution of Government of Tamil Nadu. Thus, Rs.642.74 crore (100 million US\$) will be the loan assistance from World Bank and Rs.275.46 crore (42.85 million US\$) from the Government of Tamil Nadu.

5. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project in his proposal has furnished the following items in detail for implementation of Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project.

3. Project Location and Phasing
4. Project Beneficiaries
5. Methodology
6. Implementation Structure
7. Project Cost

He has also furnished the details of the posts to be filled up with qualification, emoluments and source of recruitment for the State/ District/ Block Level.

6. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project has therefore requested the Government to issue an administration sanction for the Project to proceed further as per Project Implementation Plan.

7. The Government have after careful examination of the proposal of Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project and hereby issue the following orders:-

- i) to accord administrative sanction of Rs.918.20 Crores (Rupees Nine hundred and eighteen crore and twenty lakh only) for the implementation of Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project .
- ii) to approve the proposal for implementation of the Tamil Nadu Rural Transformation Project as per annexure I to this order.
- iii) World Bank conditions for staff structure have to be fulfilled. The details of the posts to be filled up with qualification, emoluments and source of recruitment for the State/ District/ Block Level as per Annexure II to this order.

8. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.59866/RD/2018, dated 20.11.2018.
